*These are cigars which are known for their light body flavours. At the outset your palette detects sweetness and a touch of citrus, underset with a gentle tone of freshly mown grass.*

*As the cigar progress these flavours will be replaced by warm cedar, leather and gentlest hint of cinnamon.*

### *Medium*

#### **Romeo y Julieta Wide Churchills - £50.00**

*A flat robusto with a healthy-looking, medium claro wrapper.*

*Floral at first, this cigar becomes earthy and spicy with big notes of walnut and a bit of maple syrup*

### *Medium & Full Bodied*

#### **Montecristo No.4 - £30**

*The cigar produces a smooth & lush smoke, pungent with the scents of roasted coffee, caramel, vanilla & cocoa, which blends seamlessly with the medium-strength tobacco*
